
PROJECT

Person, is Michael Eberle and Dominik Brun del Re, cryptically interlocking rhythms with sophisticated sound backdrops and fragments of melodies to attain orchestral beauty since 1997. Exploring the wealth of everyday noises, Person collect and file noises to then modulate and reintegrate them into their tracks, which have been remixed by the likes of Plaid or Team Doyobi. Their stylistic arch reaches from clubby electro to improvised acoustic sets and abstract electronica to hardcore hiphop.

BIO

Michael Eberli, is a founding member of Spezialmaterial. With Sissikontest and his electronic project Person, he made himself a name in sound modulation, live-sampling and producing. His tracks have been remixed by the likes of Plaid or Team Doyobi. In countless live performances, he has shown that an audience is best gripped with musical dynamic. Michael Eberli has also developed various audio-visual installations, many of which have been exhibited at international art fairs. For his music and art project, he has been awarded numerous prizes. .

Dominik Brun del Re, *1976, plays drums and guitar. Since his childhood, he has jammed and improvised with many professional musicians. He studied art at the F + F School in Zurich. His musical endeavours are strongly influenced by experimental hiphop and industrial. Besides making music, he also paints and has travelled widely with various performance art projects. In the mid nineties, he turned to electronic music.





Jus't Don't / SPEZIALMATERIAL (SM009EP021)

boomkat.com, You seem to like these mystery twelves as much as we do, so heres a REALLY good one for you. Artist and label wish to remain anonymous on this one, but the clues are all there if you look long enough, and the answer to the puzzle will make you take extra good care of this twelve. What you get for your hard earned is a totally mashed up slab of intricately jacked-up hip hop decimations, a gargantuan monster ripping into a certain rap classic from Cold Chillin's most dangerous hardcore rapper and a barrel load of crunk rap and r'n'b heroines. This ain't no simple blend type shiz - think pure advancement that crushes all comers into a messy pulp while bigging up the Shadetek massive. Dancefloor bombs mix with gutterized head mash acid hop, no hanging around yhear!?!?!!!! Massive.

pitchforkmedia.com, IDM is dead. But as any horror movie enthusiast of the last few decades could tell you, sometimes the dead don't know it yet. Pesky, tragic and weirdly (whisper it) cute, sometimes the dead have a funny way of rising up and stumbling around and gnawing on passersby before they finally stop twitching and give it up for real. A case in point is this faceless entity from Switzerland which strides forth from the jaws of the crypt clutching a fragment of Rakim intoning, of course, "Been a long time, I shouldn't have left you" like an 8-bit revenant. Hard crunchy flanged beats, overly filigreed electro exoskeletons, mp3-converted ghosted-n-ripped hiphop-n-pop and hostage R&B divas--you know the drill. The combination's rather familiar by now, and yet it lurches on tenaciously. With sufficient volume at a party, the wax would still lead with brutal efficiency to zombie shoulder rolling behavior on the dancefloor. The lesson: IDM is dead, long live IDM. [Drew Daniel]

From Person to you / SPEZIALMATERIAL (SM003EP001)

pelicanneck.com, Bit of a special one this, attention to detail has always been a well known Swiss trait, but this sublime release on Switzerlands Spezialmaterial label has really got us by the balls - including one of the loveliest concepts in vinyl packaging we have seen and 6 tracks of total electronic perfection. This is very much in the crunchy Ae/Toytronic/ Team Doyobi vein, but the quality is seriously high, with the opening RIn Karton managing to bounce in all the right places and is just dark enough to qualify for cinematic approval. ROrte Artuis kicks in with a filtered and blanched-out skittering breakbeat and slowly simplifies itself into a tweaked electroid monster, the programing and sound control here is superb, and when the heartfelt melody refrains drop, the evolution is natural and works beautifully. The EP comes with a CD that includes some audio, some sound generators, animations and some gorgeous SM images. The whole thing is housed in a lush card sleeve thaths inserted into a semi-transparent fabric surround, this really looks amazing. For aesthetic freaks and collectors, as well as those of you into the crunchy stuff... please, dont miss out on this one!

smallfish records, at this point in time i can't stress enough how damn fine this cd is! taking influences from a range of electronic styles, from laptop textures to toy melodies, it conjures a unique magic all it's own. please check this out, it's fab!

spezial material's first foray into vinyl territory is a beautifully produced selection of tracks which transcend the easy to pigeon-hole i.d.m. category. gorgeous tones and textures with clever, intricate beats. classy stuff. the accompanying cd has eight sound file, sound scape textural tracks plus a fun cd

groove magazin, Die Verpackung ist so schoen wie geheimnisvoll, in ihr steckt eine 6-Track-12" ("From Person To You") und eine CD ("In Person") mit 22-minuetigem Audio-Inhalt und CD Rom-Teil. Die Audio-CD enthaelt abstrakte Geräuschkunst in der Art der fruehen Mego-Schule. Bearbeitete Feldaufnahmen bescheren uns ein, durch eine thematisch immer wieder auftauchende Flaeche verbundenes, auf- und abschwellendes Rauschen, Brummen und Schaben. Sicher besser als vieles auf diesem abgegrasten Sektor der ach so experimentellen Musik, leidet das Stueck dennoch daran, dass es zuviel Vergleichbares gibt. Umso schoener die ca. 45-minuetige 12". Sie ist voll der erlesensten Artificial-Intelligence-Warp- und speziell Mittelphasen-Autechre Elektronik. Feinstgearbeitete, vertrackte Beatstrukturen brechen sich an komplexen Soundflaechen, so duester wie dicht Æ und obwohl die Musik einen gewissen Old School-Charme verbreitet, klingt sie immer noch frisch. Eher frischer als die zunehmend koerpervergessene Post-Autechre-Frickel-Szene.
